Skyler Kogachi, Schism Design Architecture on behalf of BP International, Inc., 12615-12625 Pioneer Boulevard; a request to: 1) renovate the exterior of an existing commercial center; and 2) establish a master sign program for the existing commercial center.

Staff Recommendation: That the Planning Commission:

- (1) Adopt Resolution No. 16-01 to approve Precise Development Plan No. 1960 subject to the conditions of approval contained in respective Exhibit "A"; and
- (2) Adopt Resolution No. 16-02 to approve Sign Use Permit No. 282 subject to the conditions of approval contained in respective Exhibit "A".

**3. NOTICE OF CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION (CLASS 32)
PRECISE DEVELOPMENT PLAN NO. 1940
TENTATIVE TRACT MAP NO. 72993**

Parimal Shah of Barnwall Townhomes, 11149 Barnwall Street (also known as APN 8078-026-051), a request to construct a new multi-family residential development consisting of seven townhomes.

Staff Recommendation: That the Planning Commission:

- (1) Adopt Resolution No. 16-03 to approve Precise Development Plan No. 1940 subject to the conditions of approval contained in respective Exhibit "A"; and
- (2) Adopt Resolution No. 16-04 to approve Tentative Tract Map No. 72993 subject to the conditions of approval contained in respective Exhibit "A".

Planning Commission Action: Approved staff's recommendation by a vote of 4-0.
